

Rex Healthcare has begun construction of our new N.C. Heart & Vascular Hospital which includes a new 200,000-square-foot tower and a parking deck. Parking is extremely limited near the Medical Office Building (MOB).

Patients arriving at the MOB have a few options including: using the complimentary valet service, being dropped off, or parking in the lot nearest the MOB. We strongly encourage everyone to use the complimentary valet service that has been implemented in an effort to navigate the construction around the Heart & Vascular Tower.

To use the valet service or drop off a patient at the entrance to the Medical Office Building, please drive to the Emergency Services Parking Lot. The Medical Office Building Entrance is located just beyond the Emergency Services Main Entrance.

Entering Rex Campus from Blue Ridge Road: Take the first right and then the first left into the Emergency Services Parking Lot. The Medical Office Building Valet and Patient Drop-off area is located just past the Emergency Services Main Entrance. Use the signs to help guide you.

Entering Rex Campus Main Entrance from Lake Boone Trail: Take the first left, follow Rex Way past the parking structure and turn right into the Emergency Services Parking Lot. The Medical Office Building Valet and Patient Drop-off area is located just past the Emergency Services Main Entrance. Use the signs to help guide you.

Although use of the complimentary valet service is highly encouraged, to park your vehicle yourself, please use the parking lot closest to the Medical Office Building.

Entering Rex Campus from Blue Ridge Road: Continue straight on Rex Way, and take the first left into the Medical Office Building Overflow Parking Lot.

Entering Rex Campus Main Entrance from Lake Boone Trail: Take the first left, and follow Rex Way past the parking structure to the next intersection. Turn right at the intersection, and then take the first left into the Medical Office Building Overflow Parking Lot.
